

ANNUAL REPORT 2017



An ECM Birthday party is often the first birthday party a child in detention has ever had. Birthday parties in detention are made festive with pizza, birthday cake, and Ted Drewes frozen custard, along with gifts for the birthday celebrants and lively bingo games for all! ECM volunteers for decades have provided children in the City and County Detention Centers with monthly birthday parties. A sponsoring church or organization hosts the monthly birthday party at each detention center in honor of those children who celebrate a birthday that month. 2017 Highlights

ECM Serves New Facilities

St. Louis City and County Detention Centers are still the primary service sites for the ECM chaplains to minister to youth in the juvenile justice system. However, the chaplains' relationships with youth can now be continued after some leave the detention centers and go to Missouri Hills, a Division of Youth Services (DYS) residential facility. DYS is the state agency charged with the care and treatment of youth committed to its custody by one of the Missouri juvenile courts. The agency's services include assessment, care and treatment, and education of all youth committed to its care. ECM hosted a holiday party on December 18th for the 85 residents at Missouri Hills that included a faith hip hop concert, refreshments, and gifts for all!

Some youths in the juvenile justice system are "certified as adults" and transferred to the adult criminal system due to the serious nature of their alleged offenses. Once certified as an adult, the youths are transferred to the city or county adult justice centers, where previously ECM chaplains were not able to visit them. During 2017, ECM met with staff at the St. Louis City and St. Louis County Justice Centers and gained approval to visit with certified youths. The Chaplains are grateful to now minister to these youths who are often anxious and stressed due to the uncertainty of their situations.

Updated Video

In October 2017, ECM rolled out its updated video at the Moment in Time Gala. The video now includes Chaplains Jeff Fabbiano and Kevin Aldridge, along with scenes with detainees at the new St. Louis County Detention Center that opened in December 2016. 

Dear Friends of ECM.

Episcopal City Mission finished 2017 financially sound due to another year of strong individual donor and foundation grant support, along with excellent growth in our investment income. However, in 2018 and beyond, ECM must secure new donors and sources of grants to stay financially strong, so we can continue and expand ECM's mission of providing chaplains to children in the juvenile justice system.

As noted in the 2017 highlights on page 2, ECM is now serving more youths in new locations and can continue growing those served, as we explore new ways to serve the children in the juvenile justice system. The ECM Board and staff members will be reaching out to our supporters via personal or broader communications to update you and request your help with our plans for expansion. We will need your continued assistance!

There were over 7,600 ECM chaplain interactions with children in the juvenile justice system this year, including almost 700 one-one-one conversations. In addition, the chaplains managed 24 monthly birthday parties with volunteers and distributed holiday gifts to about 115 children.

The Ministry of Birthday Parties

You might ask, how are birthday parties a form of ministry? Birthday parties do many things.

First, they acknowledge and celebrate the birth and life of the individual. For the child in detention, the party is a statement of validation, affirmation and a celebration of all that God has created them to be. I constantly remind the children that they are "fearfully and wonderfully made" by God. Their life has value in spite of their current circumstances. The chaplains, the volunteers and the staff speak to the goodness in them. The smiles and the appreciation of the birthday honorees, as well as the rest of the children, bring goodness, peace and comfort to their well-being. For some, it fills the gap for not being able to celebrate with family and friends. For some, this may have been the first time anyone has celebrated them. *Psalms 127:3 Behold, children are a heritage and gift from the Lord, the fruit of the womb a reward*. (KJV)

Second, birthday parties provide an opportunity for additional ministry. The volunteers from the various churches in the Diocese, become the arms, legs, feet, heart, eyes, and ears of God in fulfilling his work. As followers of Christ, we are called to serve and visit those who are imprisoned and to show the love of Christ. Each volunteer serves the children pizza, soda, cake and ice cream; and then sits and eats with them, engaging in conversation. The conversations are a combination of sharing experiences on both sides and are always encouraging to the children. I am always inspired as I watch the interaction of different worlds (cultural, socioeconomic status, age, etc.) coming together and each person growing from the experience – witnessing God's work in the children and the volunteers.

Third, the birthday parties also minister to the staff in the detention centers. They serve as a reminder to many of them, who are also believers, that God has placed these children in their care. These children are precious to Him and the staff are called to be good caretakers. When I offer a public prayer of blessing over the birthday parties, as well as in chapel, I include the staff, because God has placed them over his children and they need God's help in fulfilling this very important role.

Yes, birthday parties are ministry. They speak to the soul of the honorees and the celebrants. The volunteers support the work of the chaplains in providing additional validation and expressions of God's love. In 1 Corinthians 3:6-9 (NIV) Paul writes: I planted the seed, Apollos watered it, but God has been making it grow. So neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but only God, who makes things grow. The one who plants and the one who waters have one purpose, and they will each be rewarded according to their own labor.

For we are co-workers in God's service; you are God's field, God's building. The donors provide the resources (seeds) that support the ministry in the detention centers and the chaplains and volunteers, serve the children (water) through the services they provide, i.e., birthday parties, etc. We are all co-laborers in this ministry to God's children, and God will ultimately get the increase.
